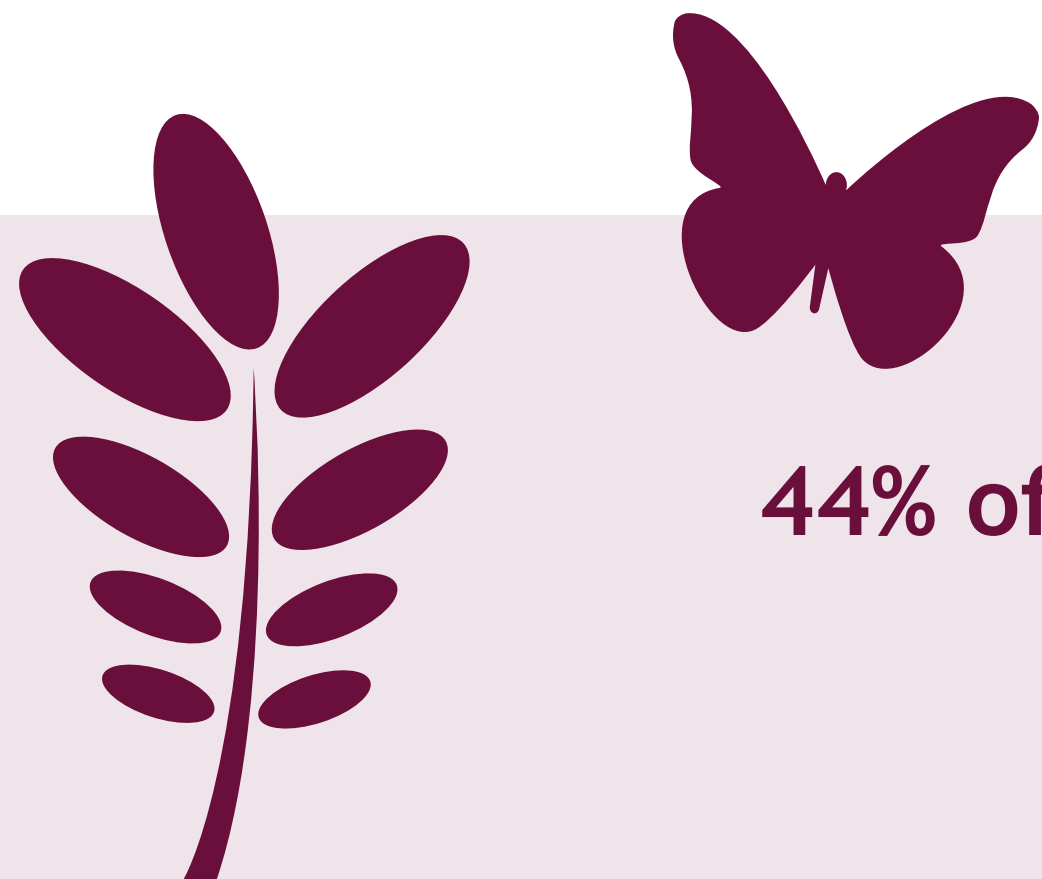


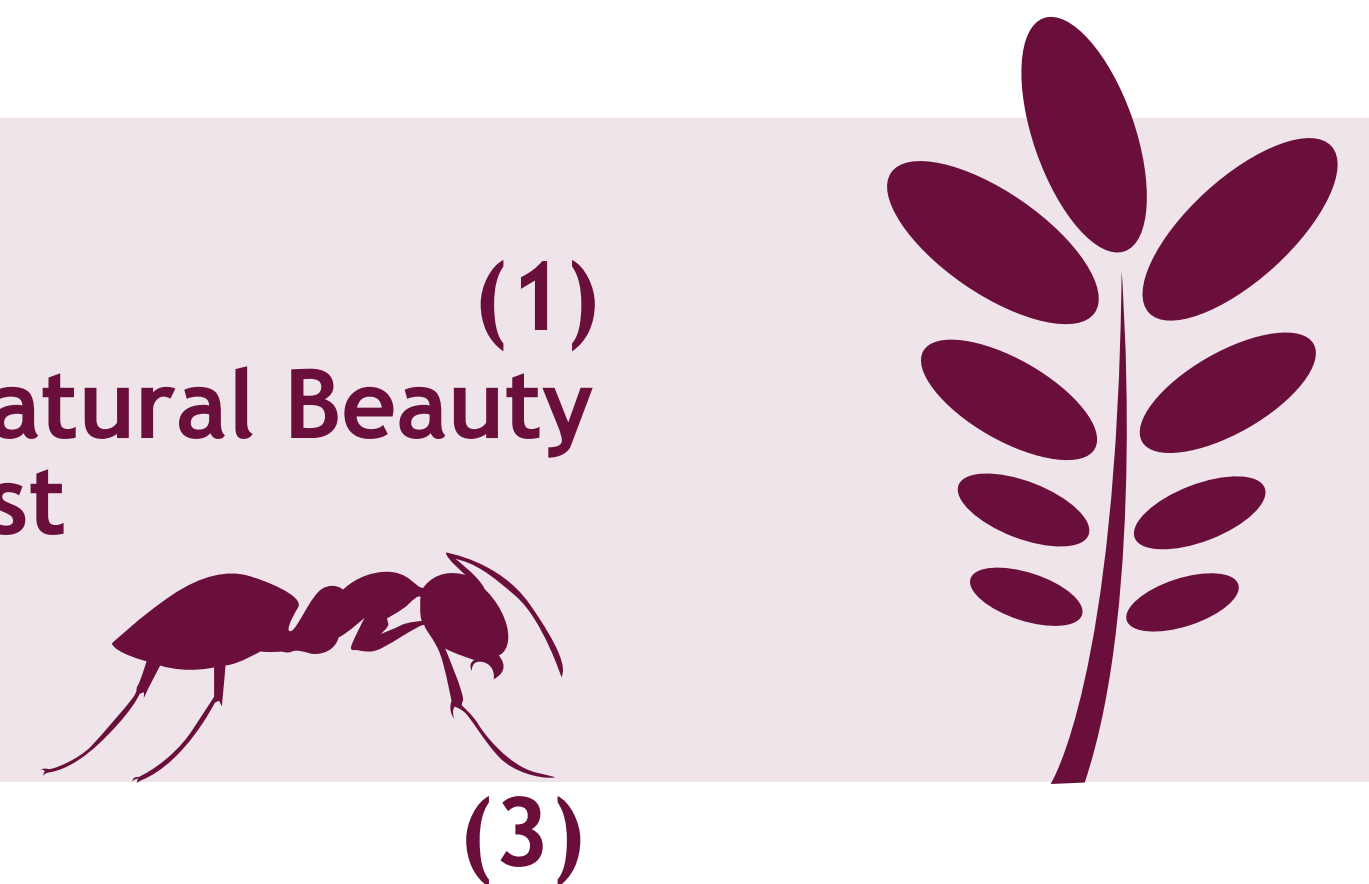


Wider Determinants

Natural and Built Environment

44% of Wiltshire is a designated Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and 9% is a Site of Special Scientific Interest



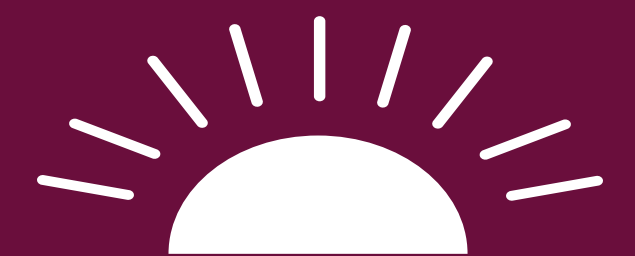
(2)
18% of surveyed adults in Wiltshire had visited the natural environment in the past 7 days for exercise/health reasons. This is very close to the England average (17.9%)



(3)
23,965 households in Wiltshire are in fuel poverty - 11.8% (England 11%)



(4)
The Warm and Safe service has supported over 800 cold homes referrals, achieving over £52,000 worth of savings on annual energy bills

Welfare



11,980 children in Wiltshire are living in poverty (11.8%). (1)

This is well below the England rate (19.9%) but there is considerable variation within Wiltshire, from 0.5% to 41.6%.



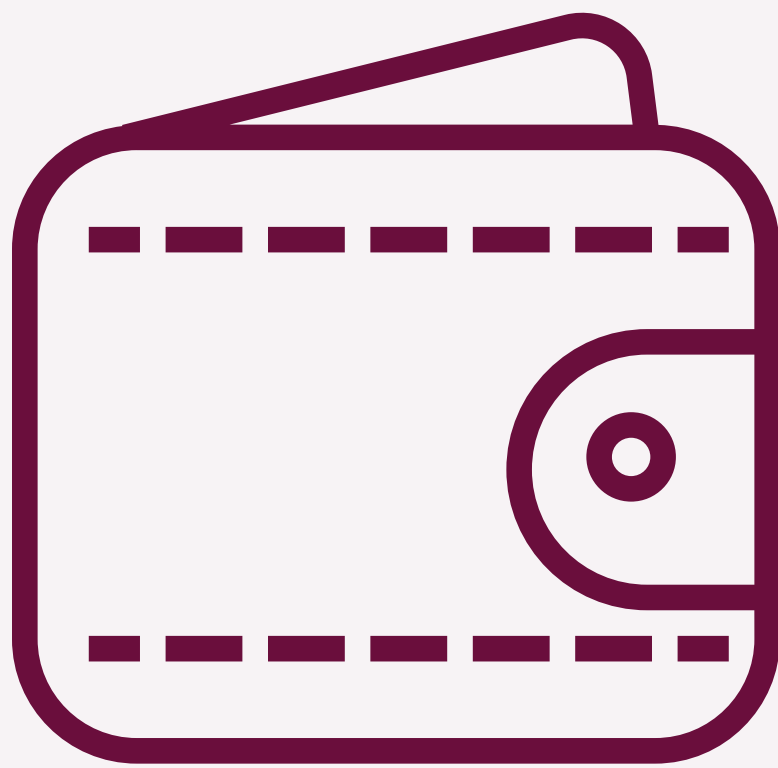
1% of working age adults in Wiltshire are unemployed and seeking work. This compares to 1.9% in England

10.5% of people aged 60+ are on low incomes (16.2% England)

4.1% of working age adults in Wiltshire are unable to work due to illness or disability. This compares to 5.8% in England

31,676 people with disabilities in Wiltshire receive financial support to help with their mobility or care needs

Education

54% of Wiltshire's primary school pupils are meeting expected standards (53% in England)

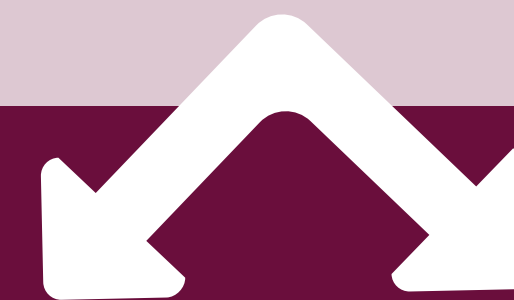


More girls than boys achieve this (57% to 50% in both Wiltshire and England)

33% of disadvantaged pupils achieve this (39% in England)

Wiltshire's secondary school pupils have an average attainment 8 score of 51.4% (49.9% in England)

Girls have a higher average score than boys (53.4% to 49.4%). In England the average score is 52.3% for girls and 47.7% for boys

The average score of disadvantaged pupils is 38.4% (41.1% in England)

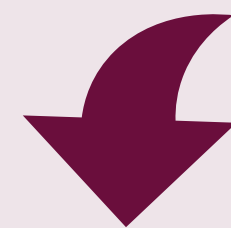


Wider Determinants

Community Safety

6,892 violent and sexual offences were reported to police in Wiltshire in 2015/16 (1)

This is a rate of 14.3 per 1000 people in Wiltshire compared to 18.9 in England



This represents a rate increase in Wiltshire since 2011/12 of 6.8, compared to an increase of 6.4 in England



Road accidents (2)

669 people were killed or seriously injured on Wiltshire's roads between 2013 and 2015

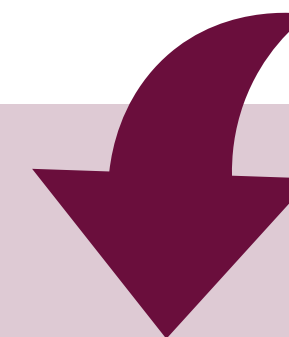
14 per 100 km of road (England is 20.8) or 46.2 per 100,000 residents (England is 38.5)



Domestic abuse (3)

3,354 domestic abuse incidents were recorded by police in 2015/16

This is a rate of 8.5 per 1000 people aged 16+ in Wiltshire, compared to 12.9 in England



This represents a 66% increase in Wiltshire since 2011/12

There has been a 78% increase in MARAC referrals over the same timeframe

Social care



2,692 people in Wiltshire receive support to live in the community

This represents 7 per 1000 adults aged 18+ in Wiltshire, compared to 10.5 in England

Care homes

There were 511 new care home placements in NHS Wiltshire in 2015/16, a rate of 1.3 per 1000 adults. England's rate is 1.5

There are 2,634 nursing home beds in NHS Wiltshire area (5.9 per 100 people aged 75+). England's rate is 4.9

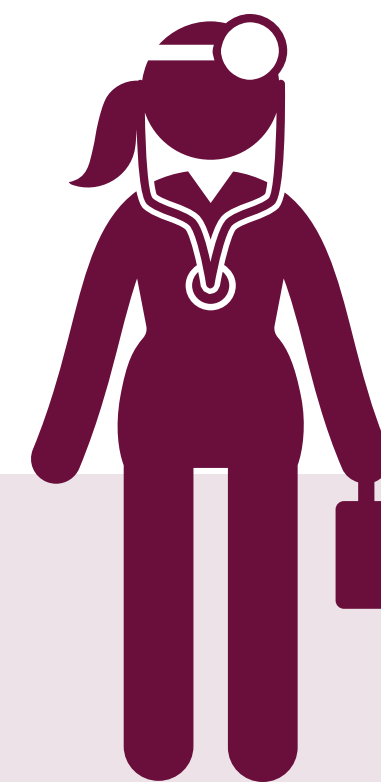
There are 5,041 residential care home beds in NHS Wiltshire area (11.2 per 100 people aged 75+). England's rate is 10.3



Carers

12,107 carers are known to Carer Support Wiltshire, of whom 35.1% are known to be aged 65+

3,180 referrals to Carer Support Wiltshire in 2016/17
